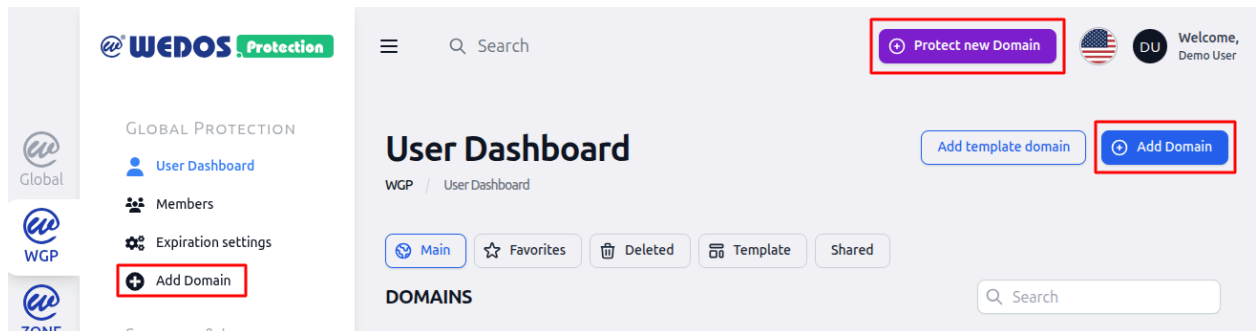


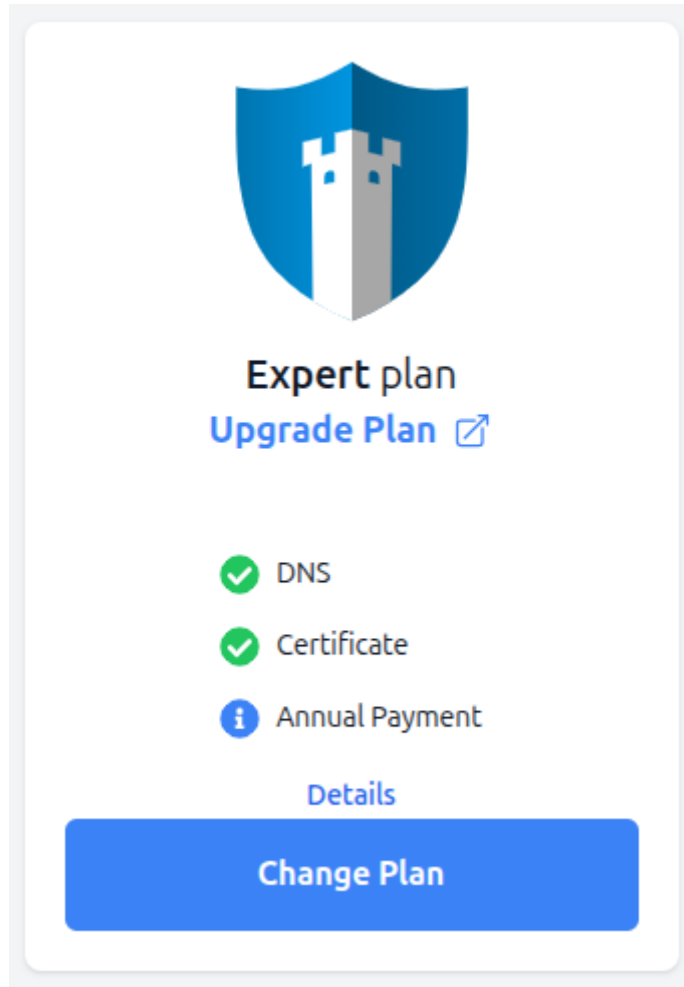
How to Add/Protect a New Domain

1. Log in to WEDOS Global at <https://client.wedos.global> to access the WGP dashboard.
2. In the **WGP User Dashboard** click **Add Domain** or **Protect new Domain**.



3. Enter a domain or subdomain* name without www.
4. Click **Continue**.
5. Choose the correct **DNS Provider** option:
 - a. If WEDOS is your primary DNS provider, select **WEDOS NS (recommended)****.
 - b. If your primary DNS provider is not WEDOS, select **Custom NS servers with CNAME records or similar (e.g. ANAME, ALIAS, CNAME Flattening)*****.
 - i. **Please note:** this option requires you to manually make changes to the DNS records for your domain with the domain provider.
6. Click **Continue**.
7. The current DNS records for your domain will be scanned and displayed after some time.
 - a. **Please note:** the scan results may not show all of the DNS records you have in your zone file, but this will not affect the functionality of WEDOS Protection. The actual records in the authoritative DNS zone file, as well as the Target IPs in WGP, are what allow WGP to function correctly.
8. Click **Continue**.
9. If further changes to the domain's DNS records or name servers are necessary, instructions will be displayed in the Dashboard.
 - a. **Please note:** making changes to DNS servers can take minutes, hours, or even days to fully propagate.

10. If everything is set up correctly, you should see a green check mark next to **DNS** and **Certificate** under the current Subscription plan on the Dashboard for the new domain.



11. As a final verification, you can make sure that the Target IPs are correct to make sure WGP points to the web server. To do this, click **Target IPs** in the WGP tab.
