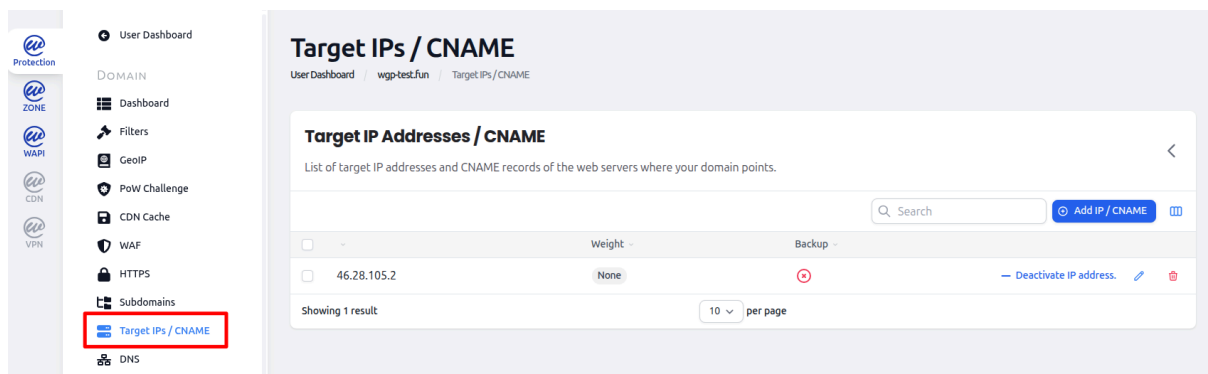


How to Update Target IPs / CNAME

In order for WEDOS.protection to function correctly, the Target IPs / CNAME for each domain must be set to the correct origin/web server IPs or CNAME for the domain. If these are not configured correctly during setup, or the web server is moved or has a new IP address or CNAME target, then you must update the Target IPs / CNAME in WGP to avoid downtime.

To update Target IPs / CNAME in WGP:

1. Log in to WGP at <https://client.wedos.global>.
2. In the **Domain** detail, navigate to **Target IPs / CNAME**.



3. Click **Add IP / CNAME** and enter the new IPv4, IPv6, or CNAME upstream target.
 - a. **Please note:** Your web service might only use IPv4.
4. Deactivate old Targets and activate new Targets.
 - a. **Please note:** Changes to Targets take effect immediately, so do not activate the new Target until the web server configuration is complete.
